
WATER WARRIOR

THE MESSAGE IS LOUD AND CLEAR

Do you know that we have fought battles for salt? In the last two decades, we have witnessed two naked aggressions in the Middle East for oil. "The third war will be fought over water." said the late King Hussein of Jordan and Boutros Ghali of UNO. By the year 2025 more then 40 countries are expected to experience stringent water crises.

"Everybody knows that we have an increase in population, but we do not have a corresponding increase in water. So a future war over water is a distinct possibility," says Toepfer, Director General of the United Nations Environment Programme. "Water is synonymous with life," writes Thomas Dixon of the Toronto University. "Now let's see how our life will be affected in the future if we are not prepared right now."

- ► Shortage of water will reduce food production.
- ► Aggravate poverty and disease.
- ► Set of large migrations.
- ► These stresses can tear apart a poor society's social fabric causing chronic population unrest and violence.

To save water many countries are moving away from water intensive crops. They have also stopped using fertilizer and pesticides to keep safe ground as well as surface water supplies from contamination. The message is loud and clear:



Do you know, a tap that drips once every second waste about 1,000 liters of water every month.

In our first year from Feb. 2007 (Global Year of Water) to Feb. 2008 **DROP DEAD** team visited 1666 houses in Mira Road, fixed 414 leaking taps free of charge and saved about 4.14 lakh liters of water. So far (2014) 3 million liters of water.

Every year the school children of Mira Road (Mumbai) participate in the rallies on five different routes covering the whole township in an attempt to create awareness amongst people.
